

Festival of Trees Prize Raffle Rules of Play

- 9 prizes will be awarded
- Prizes Total Valued at \$9,850
- Only 29,490 tickets will be sold.

Interpretation

In these Rules and Regulations, and in all electronic or printed material related to this lottery:

"AGCO" means the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario;

- "Association" means The Ontario Lung Association, operating as the Lung Health Foundation;
- "Raffle System" means the AGCO approved electronic raffle system operated by the Association for the conduct of this lottery;
- "Raffle Ticket" means a ticket, or electronic receipt for a particular Draw issued by the Raffle System which contains one or more Numbers;
- "Draw" means the random selection of a Winning Number which determines the Winning Ticket using a Random Number Generation (RNG) System;
- "Draw Time" means the time at which the Draw is originally scheduled takes place, or when a draw is not able to take place for any reason, the soonest available time after the close of the raffle;
- "Number" means a unique number issued by the Raffle System as set out on a Raffle Ticket which provides a chance at winning the Prize;
- "Player" means a person who is at least 18 years of age who is not a Related Party and who is otherwise eligible to purchase a Raffle Ticket in accordance with the Rules;
- "Rules" means these rules of play;

"Related Party" has the meaning set out below;

- "Prize" means the consideration or item identified by the Association that is provided to the winner of a draw in return for the purchase of a valid ticket;
- "Winner" means the person who is the bearer of a winning ticket and who satisfies all conditions established by the Association to claim the prize;
- "Winning Number" means the number of a valid ticket selected as the winner during a draw,
- "Winning Ticket" means a valid ticket that bears a ticket number matching the winning number of a draw.

Eligibility

The following individuals and all of their immediate family members residing in the same household are prohibited from ordering a ticket and/or claim a prize:

(a) Members of the Association's Board of Directors;

(b) Full time, part-time and student employees of the Association,

(c) Persons who are directly on the Association's payroll;

(d) The Association's employees who are on paid or unpaid leave;

(e) Persons under the age of 18 years;

(f) Employees of the supplier of the Raffle System who are involved with the development and/or support of the Raffle System; and

(g) Such other persons designated from time to time as Related Party by the Association.

Participants must be at least 18 years of age. Tickets cannot be ordered in the name of a minor. Only tickets that have been paid for and/or have been verified as paid for are eligible to be entered for the respective draw(s). Tickets must be ordered and delivered within the province of Ontario.

By purchasing a ticket, you agree to allow the Association, and its licensed gaming suppliers providing services to this program, the right, if you are a prize winner, to use and publicly disclose your name, municipality of residence, image, photograph and likeness as a prize winner in any means required by the terms of our lottery license and/or that we consider appropriate for purposes of administering and promoting the lottery, without notice, review or approval or additional compensation to you.

The liability of the licensee of this lottery shall be limited to the purchase price of the ticket.

Sales and Issuance of Raffle Tickets

A Player physically located in Ontario, Canada may purchase Raffle Tickets for a Draw held by the Association online through the following portal <u>www.festivalraffle.ca</u> which is connected to the Raffle System. A Player will be required to comply with the instructions on the website in order to purchase a Raffle Ticket. Upon completion of the registration but prior to the purchase of a Raffle Ticket, a Player will be required to verify the information is complete and accurate.

A Player may participate by purchasing a Raffle Ticket in the following denominations:

- (a) 3 Ticket Numbers for \$5.00;
- (b) 10 Ticket Numbers for \$10.00; and/or
- (c) 60 Ticket Numbers for \$20.00

A Player is solely responsible for maintaining and preserving the Raffle Ticket once it has been issued by the Raffle System.

The official ticket is a receipt of purchase. It is the responsibility of ticket purchasers to ensure that they receive their ticket/s; however, participants do not need their ticket/s in hand in order to be included in the respective draw/s. No refunds will be issued after commencement of the draws. Ticket purchases are not tax deductible.

Official tickets will be delivered to the customer via email within 3-5 business days. Physical ticket(s) will be mailed to the address provided at the time of the order within 7-10 business days.

Draw Control and Draw Order

A Draw will be conducted at the Draw Time by two Association employees using the EMT Terminal in accordance with applicable Regulations. The draw will be conducted at 18 Wynford Drive, Suite 401, Toronto, ON M3C 0K8 on or about 10:00 AM EST on November 20, 2020, or as soon as possible thereafter if circumstances prevent the draw from taking place at the scheduled time.

Tickets ordered before the final sales deadline will be eligible for all 9 draws.

Winning Numbers are eligible for all subsequent prize draws.

Prizes will be awarded to the individual(s) named on the official ticket. Prize notification letters are addressed to the primary ticketholder. It is the responsibility of the primary ticketholder to allocate the prize if necessary. Prizes awarded may not be exactly as illustrated.

Prize winners are asked to claim prizes in a timely manner following notification. **Prize** winners are responsible for claiming their prizes in-person from Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario. Prize winners are responsible for any and all expenses incurred to do so, which may include but not limited to shipping costs and car mileage. Any prizes which are not claimed shall be secured for a period of six (6) months from the date of the draw. Unclaimed prizes will be reported, and a charitable allocation will be approved by the licensing body.
